

Donation of Medical Equipment and Supplies to Azile, Haiti



L'Azile is a small village in the South of Haiti. ADA (Association pour le Développement de l'Azile) is an organization that works for the promotion of l'Azile. The Association, a member of the Coalition, has built a 3 building hospital with funds from the Haitian Government, their constituencies and other sources. HCP has sent medical equipment to supply the hospital. The pictures detail different moments of that activity.



The list of equipment sent and received by the Hospital includes but not limited to: beds, office furniture, basic medical supplies, IV Poles, portable X-Ray machine, medical equipment and other items to start servicing the people in their community. They needed help to open the hospital as quickly as possible because people in that area



In June 2009, two board members of A.D.A. (Association for the Development of l'Azile) presented to the HCP Board to explain the situation of l'Azile and presented a list of items the hospital needs to start servicing the people. The core members of HCP understood the gravity of the situation and at the same time felt the urgency to help them. They then turned to Mr. James Harrison president of the Mission Relief for help. In less than a month a container loaded with medical equipment and supplies was ready to be shipped to Haiti. Working with Mr. Felix Augustin, General Consul of Haiti in New York HCP was able to facilitate the transportation and the delivery of these merchandises to L'Azile, Haiti. We are happy that l'Azile Hospital was able to open their doors and since January 2010 these materials have been put to good use.
